**Minute with Mike Young, D. Min.,**  
Associational Director of Missions

The last five years of my Dad’s life were spent in a nursing home. During that time his favorite pastime was putting together jigsaw puzzles. He had me to have framed a half dozen of them which hung in his room on the walls and were displayed in the lobby on an easel in a rotation. Several were bought for him and many were given to him. I donated his closet full to the nursing home upon his death. He would not accept one which was not in the original box with the big picture of how the completed puzzle should look on the top. He said that it was next to impossible to put the puzzle together without it. Even with the big picture on the box I often found him hard at work on a large puzzle and very frustrated. He would take a break as we visited and resume with some new success after I left. You might be successful in getting the edges and small sections in the corners together without the big box picture. Your work would be painfully slow and frustrating as you held up each piece and wondered, “Where does this fit?”



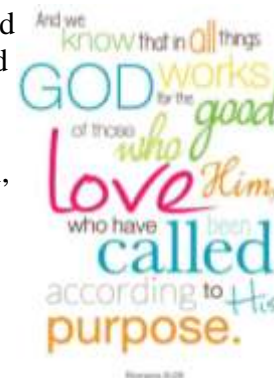
The same is true in life. Some pieces of life’s puzzle do not make sense when seen by themselves. We wonder where our disappointments and failures fit in. We want life’s box top picture which would assure us that all of our experiences have a purpose. God, however, does not provide us with that box top picture of our life, but he does promise us in Romans 8:28 that every experience in life’s puzzle will be used for some good. That does not mean that every one of our experiences will be good, but that there will be no missing or useless experiences or pieces. God will fit all of our experiences together; making even the painful and confusing times into a beautiful picture that is beautiful and makes sense in the end, like Dad’s framed puzzle masterpieces.
