Minute with Mike Young, D. Min.,
Associational Director of Missions

This morning I was reading in John Chapter 12 and paused to reflect on the words in verse 21, “Sir, we would see Jesus”. The story told to be by Pastor Elise when our association’s mission team was serving in American Samoa in 2009 came to mind. He told of a missionary who visited one of the islands of the South Pacific. When he told the natives there about Jesus, one of them remarked, “Oh, he used to live here“. The missionary, surprised, inquired further about this man. He learned that many years earlier a missionary had spent some time on the island. He did not know the Polynesian language of the people, but he had helped them in every possible way, and his life showed the natives his love for them. Now as the natives heard about Jesus in their language, they concluded that he must have been the man who had lived with them years earlier. The pastor and I discussed whether we as Christians are so like Jesus that people recognize him in our lives. Do they see Jesus in us? It is still a good question for us to ask. The world is still looking for Christianity to be lived out in us. The words of B. B. McKinney, the great Southern Baptist hymn writer in 1924 wrote, ”Let Others See Jesus in You. I like the last line of that great hymn, “Keep telling the story, be faithful and true, let others see Jesus in you”. Do others see Jesus in you?
