During the Centennial Exposition in Philadelphia an Oriental vine made its American debut. It was called Kudzu. It was a sign which could grow a foot in one day. It was promoted at the Exposition as a plant which could grow anywhere in the United States and could help to control soil erosion. It did live up to its reputation as a way to control soil erosion, but it covered not only the ground all over the South, it started covering signs, telephone poles, etc. By the 1950s people everywhere in the South began regretting that they had ever planted it. Plant scientists continue in 2016 to try to find a way to destroy it. Sin is like that. It starts by promising to fulfill some need or desire in our lives, but then grows and damages our life. It, too, is hard to eradicate, but in sin's case we have the way to destroy it and its damaging effects, **JESUS**.
