This all is the main difference in Southern Baptist.

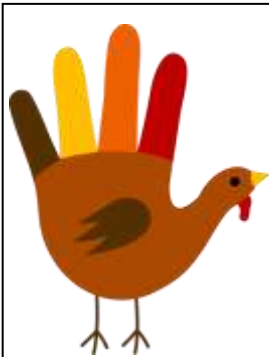
